Borax Argentina

Partnership – School “No. 4398” in Campo Quijano

Borax donated equipment and supplies for repairs and construction, and supports the school’s educational programs.

Borax España

Partnership – University of Castellon

Student scientists conduct research they need to earn their degrees on borates, including some on borates’ ability to lower energy and waste in ceramic tile body manufacture.

Borax Europe Limited – Guildford England

Partnership – British Trust for Conservation Volunteers- BTCV

Through its partnership with the British Trust for Conservation Volunteers, Borax employees volunteer to clear heath land and supply safety equipment.

Partnership – Horticulture High School of Dunkirk

Partnership – Deltalings

This partnership addresses waste management and traffic safety in the Port of Rotterdam, and has been recognized through the Port’s prestigious Horti Award.
